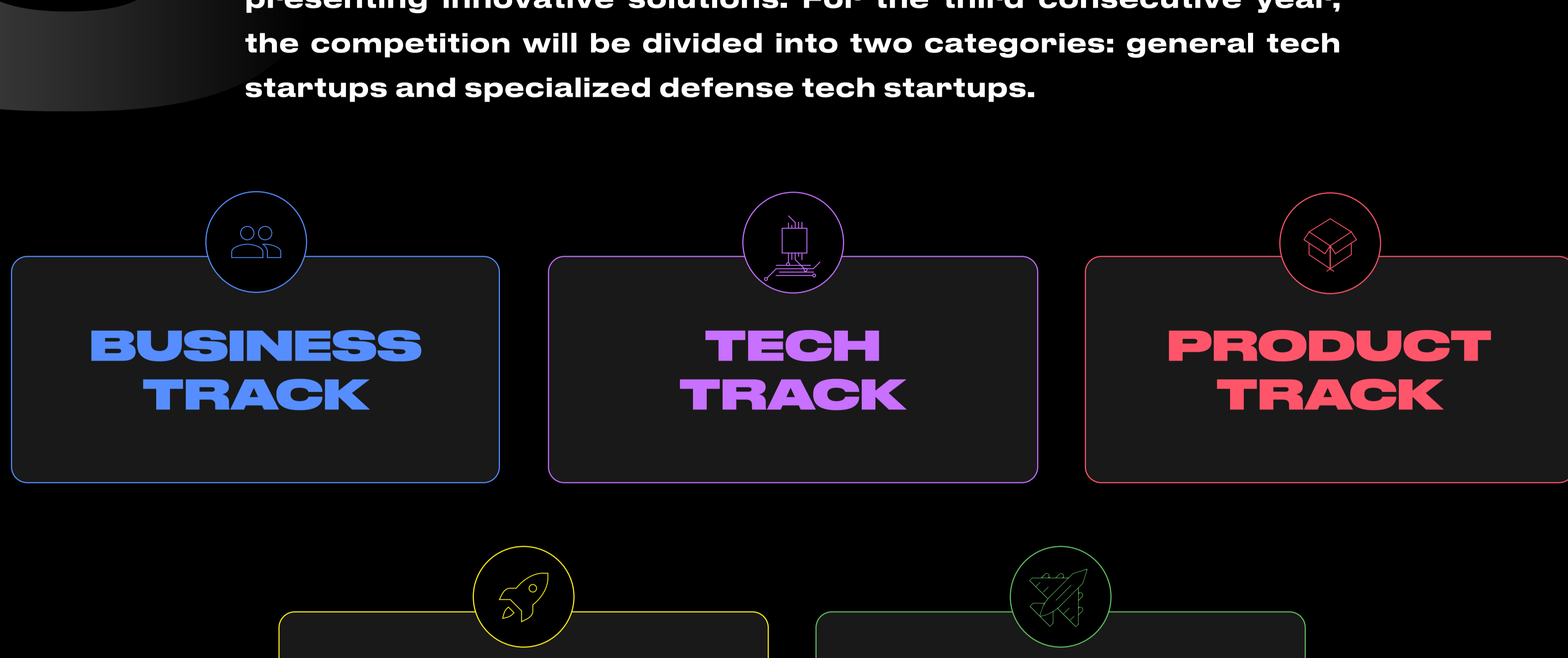
ATTENDEE PROFILE

At IT Arena 2025, we will bring together over 6,000 attendees from 30 countries. The event will attract professionals from the technology business and related industries, engineers and developers, investors and startups, government and associations, international funds, and media.



5 THEMATIC STAGES

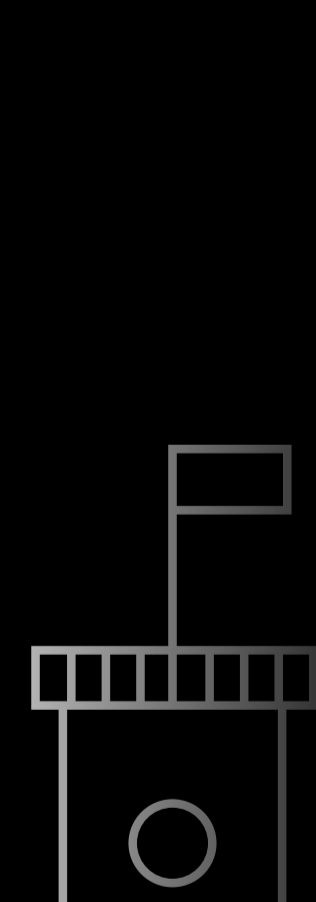
In 2025, IT Arena will offer attendees the opportunity to shape their event experience through five distinct stages: Business, Tech, Product, Startup (General), and Startup (Defense Tech). The IT Arena Startup Competition will showcase over 100 startups presenting innovative solutions. For the third consecutive year, the competition will be divided into two categories: general tech startups and specialized defense tech startups.



LVIV – A THRIVING TECH HUB

Lviv, one of Ukraine's largest tech hubs, ranks second in the country for both the number of tech specialists and the economic impact of its tech sector.

There are currently 617 tech companies in the Lviv region, up from 192 in 2015 based on the IT Research Ukraine study. The city's startup ecosystem, fueled by collaborations between universities and tech companies, make it a magnet for young professionals and foreign investors.



TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

Due to martial law, air travel to Ukraine is currently prohibited. However, you can fly to Poland, where we will arrange a bus transfer across the border – Lviv is just an hour away. The IT Arena team will provide accommodation in one of the city's premium hotels.

IMPORTANT: A valid passport is required to enter Ukraine; an EU ID card or any other travel document is not sufficient.

For the upcoming IT Arena in 2025, our foremost concern is ensuring the highest level of security for our visitors. Drawing from our experience hosting events during the pandemic and since the start of the invasion, we have equipped our venue with reliable shelters and on-site emergency services.
